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**PSPCC Resolution No. 04  
Series of 2019**

**APPROVING THE PHILSYS IMPLEMENTATION PLAN 2019-2022**

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of Republic Act (RA) No. 11055 mandates the PhilSys Policy and Coordination Council (PSPCC) to formulate policies and guidelines to ensure effective coordination and implementation of the Philippine Identification System (PhilSys);

**WHEREAS**, the Council reached an agreement during the 5<sup>th</sup> PSPCC Meeting that the PSA shall formulate a clear implementation plan/strategy for the PhilSys with assistance from member agencies and technical resource persons;

**WHEREAS**, Section 18.b of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 11055 stipulates that the PSPCC shall facilitate inter-agency cooperation and collaboration in the implementation of the PhilSys;

**WHEREAS**, Section 18.c of the IRR of RA 11055 further states that the PSPCC shall consult and enlist the assistance and support of relevant government agencies, the academe, as well as private institutions or persons, as may be necessary in the formulation, review, or amendment of policies and guidelines;

**WHEREAS**, the PSA, in cooperation with the Asian Development Bank (ADB) and World Bank, conducted a three-day strategic planning workshop on 15 to 17 January 2019 for the formulation of the PhilSys Implementation Plan with particular Council members, technical resource persons, and PSA officials in attendance;

**WHEREAS**, the PSA further organized a technical specifications workshop on 30 January to 01 February 2019 as input to the PhilSys Implementation Plan with Inter-Agency Committee (IAC) member agencies, technical resource persons, and PSA officials in attendance;

**WHEREAS**, the outputs of the identified workshops and other related meetings were consolidated, harmonized, and finalized by the ADB, World Bank, and PSA to produce the draft PhilSys Implementation Plan;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Council approves the initial PhilSys Implementation Plan 2019-2022 (Annex CR 04-20190214-01) subject to revisions based on the comments and agreements made during the 6<sup>th</sup> PSPCC Meeting;

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that the following changes shall be reflected in the document:

- (1) Inclusion of key actors in the governance of PhilSys in the IAC subgroups and the addition of PhilHealth in Legal Affairs; PhilHealth, Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas

- (BSP), and Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA) in Technology; and Philippine Overseas Employment Administration (POEA) in Registration and Validation;
- (2) Inclusion of the proposed number of registration centers by agency per region and updating of the figure for PhilHealth registration centers;
  - (3) Inclusion of the five major blocks, namely, (a) Registration Centers and Kits, (b) Automated Biometrics Information System (ABIS) and its Hardware, (c) System Integrator/Application, (d) Card Production and Personalization, and (e) Data Center, Hardware, and Connectivity and their respective timelines;
  - (4) Inclusion of the cost estimates, including personnel complement for mobile registration and overseas registration;
  - (5) Inclusion of a detailed matrix of dates vis-à-vis the general timeline for the procurement; and
  - (6) Omission of all mentions of "MOSIP" in the plan for replacement with "Open Source Identification System".

**RESOLVED FINALLY**, that the initial PhilSys Implementation Plan 2019-2022 shall be treated as a living document to be further enriched by discussions and outputs of the Council, IACs and subgroups, technical resource persons, and PSA officials.
